

Reused and Recycled Materials from House



Reused 2x4's and trim

Nails were removed from all studs and trim after deconstruction and used for re-construction. Insulation was stripped from the ruined copper pipe and along with the iron it was recycled. Heating system zones were reused. Concrete and dirt from the slab excavation were saved to reuse for “urbanite” walls and fill. Windows were reused in the greenhouses. The fiberglass insulation that was not damaged was added to the attic. The carpet was recycled in Denver. The cabinets and appliances were deconstructed by and donated to the Wheat Ridge Restore.
